Geoffrey: I'd like to see us request that the county consistently post the information we share with them or that we find an alternative that we (County & OGCC) can agree on. - To Do: Geoffrey to write the letter. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discussion about how CPO minutes are posted. Joan was told by County that only most current meeting minutes would be posted but, in fact, they did post last 2 months of minutes. Will complete CPO history of meeting minutes be published on county website? • Also, very concerning to JH and GJ; county requires editable DOCX files instead of PDF files which can't be edited. • Should CPO Summit group address this issue? 3. Geoffrey: Formal process for LUART and the OGCC (general council & Board). Standardization of LUART - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Joseph Edge's template was endorsed by all - OGCC Land Use Application Review form was discussed. OGCC Response 5th column should include not only - <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) if application meets ZDO but also b) "what the community wants". Example - heritage trees, not part of ZDO language. 4. Baldwin: Letter of support for CPO Summit requests at Feb 6 Planning Commission meeting - Karen Bjorklund is asking each CPO to write letters of support for the below A. & B. Geoffrey made a <u>motion</u> that the OGCC Board write a letter to support A. & B. Chaunda seconded. Unanimous approval. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Allow appeals of Land Use Hearings Officer's decisions to the BCC B. To Do: Baldwin to ask State Farm what annual fee for both \$100,000 and \$300,000 coverage would be.</p> <p>6. Joan: Update on Jane Civiletti's participation in Membership recording - Jane is willing to help but does not have Excel spreadsheet application on her Microsoft laptop. She will help with CMAP address review of new members and posting names and emails to MailChimp. To Do: Joan to request OGCC pay for Excel for Jane. Latest info about BCC approval - Steve from Rhododendron CPO reported their changes to by-laws were accepted apparently without BCC approval. Baldwin is collecting arguments for NOT needing BCC approval for alterations to OGCC by-law changes.</p> <p>8. Baldwin: April 26 meeting is scheduled for the Training Room which holds max 40. What should we do? - All agreed the Training Room would be fine. To Do: Baldwin Bob will follow up to see what chair/table arrangement would be best.</p>
