Past minutes were approved, financial balance was given and all attending introduced themselves.

Vahid Brown gave a presentation on the services for models of "Safety Off of the Street", an overarching category for houseless people. Non congregate Shelter is now the preferred model that homeless individuals and families, as well as service providers, prefer. Project Turnkey and the purchases of motels here in Clackamas Co. was discussed and it was noted that the Board of Commissions will be taking up this topic again tomorrow. A long question and answer period followed.

Brian Goodrich gave an update on issues from our Fire District including numbers of medical calls, and a local levy option which is planned for the spring ballot. The meeting room at the fire building on Oak Grove Blvd will be available to the community at some time in the not distant future. Smoky and/or plastic garbage burning in neighborhoods is a DEQ issue and it is that the agency to contact.

Updates were given on LUART, CERT, CPO summit, HDOG, OLGP.
